Dee Jasper began the meeting by giving an update on the test well sites. He received a proposal from Subsurface Surveys for a scope of work involving six traverses. The estimated cost is \$4,370 - \$5,490. Colder temperatures may affect the instrument, causing it to take more time to get a reading. The work is expected to take about two days, and will be paid for out of Self-Help Enterprises' Technical Assistance funds. Dee will follow up on whether or not the property owned by SEA is in escrow. If so, he will get information on the new owner. Dee will also follow up to be sure he has signed permission from each of the landowners.

Once the sites have been determined, NOEs will need to be filed before the test wells are drilled. Dave Warner recommended checking into the funding agreement special conditions to see if NOEs are required before subsurface survey can begin.

Dave Warner updated the group on the status of the claim submissions. Claim #1 was submitted in September, and the District received the check in January. The District has also submitted Claim #2 for charges incurred in the months of September, October and November.

Jesse Dhaliwal concluded by asking for updates on follow up contact with Mr. Conner from Lake of the Woods Mobile Village. Mr. Conner will be invited to come early to the next Planning Meeting to discuss any concerns, and to educate him on what is possible within the project. Jesse will be notified of the outcome, and will take over any action from that point.

The next update meeting will take place on February 20, 2020.
