Dear Mr. Sanchez:

This is a request to extend the Work Completed Date for the above-referenced consolidation project from June 30, 2024 to December 31, 2024. The project has experienced significant delays due to several conditions beyond the control of the District. These delays arose principally from the uncooperative nature of the past landowner and the current landowners of the Well 8 wellsite, the failed effort to drill a replacement well for Well 5, and the overall effects of the shutdown of our economy due to the COVID pandemic.

I will not revisit the reasons for the delays that we have experienced, as they have been discussed in previous conversations and written recounts of what has taken place except to say that the delays and the efforts involved with obtaining a wellsite for Well 8 continue. These delays have resulted in significant costs for the District and significant time expenditures for the District's staff and also for the District's engineering and legal consultants. Fortunately, we are very near the culmination of the efforts to overcome the delays, but are not there yet. We have employed the District's eminent domain powers to obtain a wellsite for Well 8 and should have that issue resolved by the end of August or mid-September. As you know – the preliminary geological and geophysical work that the District undertook to find the best site for Well 8 resulted in a very successful test well result on that site. It is the best site in the Cuddy Creek Valley to drill a new well. We are also nearing completion of negotiations with the landowners of Well 9. The test well drilled on Well 9 also revealed that it was a good selection as well.

The attached revised project schedule shows a time of work completion of December 31, 2024, which reflects the effects of the protracted time for procurement of Wellsites 8 and 9 and the CEQA work that is required for the project.
